About Logan Health – Chester:

- **How many beds:** Logan Health – Chester has 25 beds. 21 beds dedicated to LTC, 4 acute care beds, 2 bay ER. We also have observation and outpatient treatment rooms.
- **Patient demographics:** We treat all ages of the population.
- **Schedules and call requirements:** Nurses are on 12 hour shifts, 3 per week is common. There is a call requirement and holiday/ weekend rotation.

Common treatments and skill sets/procedures:

We commonly treat chest pain, stroke, sports/fall/agricultural injuries, common illnesses. ACLS and PALS required. Assessment skills, IV, EKG, medication administration. We use modern equipment and technology.
