- Patient demographics: We see all ages, newborns through geriatrics.
- Schedules and call requirements: Self-scheduling by seniority, 12-hour shifts, dayshift 0545-1815, nightshift 1745-0615, mid-shift 1200-0000. 2 Nurses and a CNA per shift, mid-shift to overlap to keep continuity of care in the ER during shift change. No call requirements. Nursing is part of the MNA union.

Common treatments & skill sets / procedures:

Strokes, Cardiac events, traumas, sepsis, diabetes, COPD, CHF, behavioral health, swing bed-rehabilitative care. Provide outpatient services as well, IV therapy, and wound care. Scope days 1 per month. ACLS, PALS, TNCC, STABLE, NRP, Assessment skills, IV, EKG, medication administration. Use of modern equipment.
