- Baby Steps works with pregnant women and their health care providers to help them have a healthy full-term pregnancy.
- Medicaid presumptive eligibility is a service provided to assist pregnant women in accessing Medicaid early in their pregnancy thereby helping them to begin prenatal care early.
- Follow Me Program begins at birth up to the age of five. Public health nurses provide screenings, parenting information, referrals and anticipatory guidance. The goal of this project is to enhance child growth and development, promote parenting and ensure early intervention services as needed so all Montana children will enter school healthy and ready to succeed.
