## Patient Etiquette for a Successful Telehealth Visit

Providing a high-quality visit is our top priority. If this cannot be accomplished virtually, your provider may ask you to reschedule an in-person visit.

## Please follow these 10 steps:

- 1. Ensure you have a mobile or desktop device with speakers, video capabilities, and a reliable internet connection.
- 2. If you plan to join from a Mac or PC, use <u>Chrome</u> or <u>Firefox</u>. To join from a mobile device, use Safari for Apple devices and Chrome for Android.
- 3. Select a location with plenty of light.
- 4. Arrange for a private location and introduce anyone joining you.
- 5. Come prepared with a list of key items (medications, allergies, medical history, and questions for your provider).
- 6. Ensure you will be located in Montana during the visit.
- 7. Prepare to give verbal permission to the provider to conduct the appointment as you begin.
- 8. Keep yourself in view and the camera steady.
- 9. Stay focused during the visit (avoid driving, running errands, background noise such as TVs or phones).
- 10. Dress as you would during an in-person visit.

You will receive a reminder 1 hour prior to the start of your visit with a join link via text message, email or both.
