

Recommended Schedule of Immunization and Well Child Visits

6-8 weeks	<p>Well baby check-up</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hepatitis B #1 • IPV #1 (polio) • DTaP #1 (diphtheria, tetanus, acellular pertussis) • Pedvax HIB #1 (haemophilus influenzae Type B) • Prevnar #1 (pneumococcal conjugate) • RotaTeq #1 (rotavirus)
4 months	<p>Well baby check-up</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li style="width: 50%;">• Hepatitis B #2 <li style="width: 50%;">• IPV #2 <li style="width: 50%;">• DTaP #2 <li style="width: 50%;">• Pedvax HIB #2 <li style="width: 50%;">• Prevnar #2 <li style="width: 50%;">• RotaTeq #2
6 months	<p>Well baby check-up</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li style="width: 50%;">• Hepatitis B #3 <li style="width: 50%;">• IPV #3 <li style="width: 50%;">• DTaP #3 <li style="width: 50%;">• Prevnar #3 <li style="width: 50%;">• RotaTeq #3 <p>Note: Starting at this age, ANNUAL Influenza vaccines are recommended prior to the start of the flu season.</p>
9 months	Well baby check-up
12 months (must be after 1st birthday)	<p>Well baby check-up</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li style="width: 50%;">• MMR #1 (measels, mumps, rubella) <li style="width: 50%;">• Hepatitis A #1 <li style="width: 50%;">• Varivax #1 (chicken pox)
15 months	<p>Well baby check-up</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li style="width: 50%;">• DTaP #4 <li style="width: 50%;">• Pedvax HIB #3 <li style="width: 50%;">• Prevnar #4
18 months	Well baby check-up
2 years old	<p>Well child check-up</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li style="width: 50%;">• Hepatitis A #2 <li style="width: 50%;">• Varivax #2 <li style="width: 50%;">• MMR #2 <p style="text-align: center;">(MMR #2/Varivax #2 may be given between ages 2-5)</p>
3 years old	Well child check-up
4 years old (must be after 4th birthday)	<p>Well child check-up</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li style="width: 50%;">• DTaP #5 <li style="width: 50%;">• IPV #4
	Annual physicals are recommended from now on.
10-12 years old	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tdap (tetanus, diphtheria, acellular pertussis) • Menactra Meningococcal • Gardasil (human papillomavirus)

Note: Some vaccines can be given in combination, such as Pediarix (DTaP/IPV/Hep B), Kinrix (DTaP/IPV) and Proquad (MMR/ARIVAX).

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
