



How to Find Out Your Measles Vaccination Status

If you're unsure whether you're protected, here's what to do:



Step 1: Check for Records

Look in these places for your immunization records:

1. Log in to myHealth app or web portal
2. Find Immunizations icon
3. Look for 2 records of "Measles, Mumps, and Rubella Virus Vaccine" around 5 years apart

You may also request vaccine records from Flathead County Health Department. Scan the QR code for more info.

Step 2: Talk to Your Provider

- Schedule a vaccine if you're unvaccinated or unsure
- Discuss the need for a titer blood test to check for immunity (regular lab charges will apply)

Know the Risk Window



- Symptoms usually appear 11-12 days after exposure (range: 7-21 days)
- A rash shows up 2-4 days after other symptoms and lasts 5-6 days
- You are contagious 4 days before and after the rash starts
