## Tax Relief Programs

### Montana Property Tax Assistance Program (PTAP)

- Qualifying applicants receive a reduced property tax rate reduction of 30, 50, or 80% on the first \$418,000 of their home's market value. Eligibility for this program is based on home ownership, occupancy requirements, income levels, and marital status.



### **Montana Elderly Homeowner/Renter Credit**

- Elderly Montana homeowners may qualify for a refundable tax credit up to \$1,150 even if they do not have to file an income tax return. For individuals 62 and older with a combined household income less than \$45,000.

### **Montana Disabled Veterans (MDV) Property Tax Assistance Program**

- Montana veterans who are 100% disabled or the unmarried surviving spouses of deceased veterans who were 100% disabled may qualify for this program.
- Qualifying applicants receive a reduced property tax rate reduction of 50, 70, 80, or 100% on their home's market value.
- Eligibility for this program is based on home ownership, occupancy requirements, military disability requirements, income levels, and marital status.

### **Montana Disabled First Responder (DFR) Property Tax Assistance**

- Montana first responders who were disabled in the line of duty or the unmarried surviving spouses of deceased first responders who died in the line of duty or as the result of an injury in the line of duty may qualify for this program.
- Qualifying applicants receive a reduced property tax rate reduction of 50, 70, 80, or 100% on their home's market value.
- Eligibility for this program is based on home ownership, occupancy requirements, disability requirements, income levels, and marital status.

### **Montana Tax Relief for Homesteads and Long-term Rentals**

- The Homestead Reduced Rate lowers property taxes for homeowners who occupy their Montana home as their principal residence for at least seven months per year. This classification carries a reduced tax rate compared to standard Class 4 residential property.
- The Long-Term Rental Reduced Rate lowers property taxes for homes and apartments rented for at least seven months of the year to a tenant who occupies the rental as a residence.

### **Montana Land Value Property Tax Assistance Program**

- The Land Value Property Tax Assistance Program for Residential Property helps residential property owners if the value of their land is disproportionately higher than the value of their home or other buildings on their land and the land has been in their family for at least 30 years.
